OUR VALUES


- **LOCAL CHURCH** We believe the local church was designed by God and is the primary instrument God uses to accomplish His Kingdom on earth.

The Dominican Republic



Proyecto Samy

Project Samy is a faith-based, non-profit organization that educates and supports the Autism community. The Banquet Network and Proyecto Samy partnered together to train local churches in the Dominican Republic and host a Night to Shine.



Night to Shine (NTS)

Night to Shine is a prom event for people with disabilities hosted by local churches around the world in partnership with The Tim Tebow Foundation.



Special Deliveries

Gift boxes were delivered to the NTS guests. The large boxes were filled with Spanish Bibles, headphones, fidget toys, candies, arts and crafts, bubbles, crowns and tiaras, and other fun items (to be opened the evening of NTS).



The Main Event

75 registered for the virtual prom, including 17 students from a school for the deaf. This was the first ever NTS in the Dominican Republic!



The Haitian Church

Through missionary connections, we were able to meet with Haitian Church pastors who wanted training to include those with disabilities. One Haitian church, Iglesia Ministerio Maranata Moyor Gracia, needed assistance caring for members with physical disabilities.



Continued Coaching

Since returning home, we have continued coaching D.R churches virtually, including Iglesia Bautista Internacional (IBI) and Iglesia Ministerio Maranata Moyor Gracia.







EVERY CHILD BELONGS CAMP

an overnight weekend for children and young adults affected by disability

This year we hosted our second annual Every Child Belongs camp on the weekend of July 8th! We had 25 campers join us for a weekend of fun, faith and fellowship. Campers enjoyed swimming, crafts, sports, music and bible study. The Banquet Network, the Baptist Convention of Maryland/Delaware, Cresthill Church and The Gathering Place Church partnered together to put on the camp for teens and adults affected by disability. Camp is one way we are reaching young individuals affected by disability with the gospel. Our prayer is that through camp we can help to invite all people with disabilities to the eternal banquet by fostering community and connections with the local church.

Next year we hope to double the number of campers. In hopes of having 50 teens and adults join us for an unforgettable weekend, we need 75 volunteers! Sign up here.


